Mr Matić graduated at the Faculty of Law, University of Zagreb in 1989.

As a legal intern he was first employed at the law firm Dragomir Modrušan dealing with the international law, insurance companies' law and intellectual property rights.

In 1990 Mr Matić continued his practice in the USA, Denver/Boulder, Colorado in Caplan & Earnest Attorneys at Law. He also gave lectures at the University of Colorado about the political situation in the former Yugoslavia and the legal systems in different European countries, focusing on the differences between the common and civil legal traditions.

In 1992 he started a post-graduate training in International Law and Trade Law at T.M.C. Asser Institute, Den Haag, Netherlands, which he finished in 1993, and returned to Zagreb to continue his career as a consultant – researcher in the area of international and former EC law.

In 1995 Mr Matić started his own legal practice.

In the period from 1995 to 2013 when he was appointed a member of the Competition Council, he represented a number of clients in different legal matters covering commercial law, labour law, and international labour law.
